They are more commonly called stickies, sweet wines or dessert wines. These wine denote themselves by their content more or less important of residual sugar which is contained naturally in the grape juice and wasn't transformed in to alcohol during the fermentation process.

Sweet grapes can be obtained by different techniques including these two:

Late Harvest Encourage the over-ripening of the grape which needs to lose some water to give a concentrated juice. This one will create semi-sweet wines also called moelleux.

Botrytis Cinerea is a natural controlled mushroom that invade the over-ripened grape without harming this one and form the famous dark rot that we also call Noble Rot. These one will create sweet and intensely sweet wines
